

Tech's contribution to the decline of Indonesia's democracy (2014-2024)


- Their algorithm has been fueling harmful political disinformation and hate speech during election in 2014, 2016, 2019.
- Contributed to the disrupting economy of independent media.
- Advanced tech is easily weaponized to surveillance and doing digital attack targeting human right defenders.



 Information and disinformation operations involve cyber troops and macro influencers.

• Digital attacks are used to silence critical groups.



Coordinated influence operations leveraging artificial intelligence have been deployed to secure electoral victories and suppress civic dissent within digital arenas, exemplified by the #IndonesiaGelap movement. Independent media institutions such as Tempo were also subjected to delegitimization campaigns, framed through narratives portraying them as "foreign proxies" allegedly financed by Soros.



- The unclear definitions of defamation, fake news, content that disturbs public order in the law and regulations, danger freedom of expression and freedom of press.
- Granting the government broad authority to request social media platforms to remove content and impose fines, without independent and transparent mechanisms.
- Content moderation is only interpreted as either removal or no removal.
- The safeguarding of citizens' rights against the potential risks posed by artificial intelligence remains severely underdeveloped.

STRATEGIC RESISTANCE AND THE CULTIVATION OF RESILIENCE

Legal mechanism: judicial review of problematic law or regulation.

Strengthening critical NGO, pro bono advocate networks, and services to respond to digital security issue.



Strengthen investigative journalism and fact-checking to monitor domestic information operations on a regular basis.

Strengthening the capacity of communities and critical groups in digital activism to create counter-narratives against pro-authoritarian government narratives and unfair algorithms.


