#### Florida sets rapists and child molesters free to strike again

Another child is dead. This time, a brown-haired, brown-eyed girl, a year younger than Jimmy Ryce.

A 1999 law passed after Jimmy was raped and murdered at age 9 is meant to protect Floridians from sex offenders by keeping the most dangerous locked up after they finish their prices genteroes.

### PRESENT DATA THROUGH STORY


The newspaper's investigation found:

- For every sex offender the state has committed under the 14-year-old Ryce law, two others have been released — only to be arrested again for a sex crime.
- From South Florida to the Panhandle, these men have cut a fresh trail
  of pain, molesting more than 460 children, raping 121 women, and
  killing 14.
- Many offenders attacked again only days after Florida let them go. Six found new victims the same day they walked out the prison gates.


### WHAT'S WRONG? HOW TO FIX?



This chart shows the average number of Facebook likes on posts by pages of the political left. The point of this chart was to show the disparity between Mr Corbyn's posts and others.




### WHAT'S WRONG? HOW TO FIX?



This chart compares government spending on pension benefits with the share of people aged 65+ for a selection of countries, with a particular focus on Brazil. To keep the chart small, the visualiser only labelled a selection of countries and highlighted those in electric blue. The OECD average is highlighted in pale blue.





The chart above shows the United States' trade deficit in goods and the number of people employed in manufacturing.





- ✓ Show the right amount of data


### **BAR CHART**

#### To show:


- · Comparison of categories
- Pattern

#### Tips:

- · Easiest to understand
- Sort from longest to shortest
- Use horizontal bars for mobile & long labels
- · Y-axis should start with 0


### **HEAT MAP**

#### To show:

- Overview/general pattern
- Not for accurate comparison
- Not to extract specific data point

#### Tips:

- Alternative to line graph when too many lines
- · Pick colors carefully
- Be mindful that it is hard to translate a color into number.



### **CHOROPLETH MAP**

#### To show:

- Pattern/comparison across geographical areas
- Not for accurate comparisonTips:
- Larger areas appear more emphasized. Consider honeycomb/hex-tile map if necessary.
- Remember to normalize your variables
- Pick color carefully


### **PIE CHART**

#### To show:

- Quick view of distribution
- Not for accurate comparison

#### Tips:

- Total must be 100%
- Not more than 5 slices
- Hard to compare sizes when values are similar
- Pick color carefully as color can make a slice looks bigger
- Bar chart is usually a better choice


### **SCATTER PLOT**

#### To show:

 Relationship between 2 variables

#### Tips:

- Many people don't understand the chart
- Avoid plotting too many data
- If you want to talk about the regression line, make sure your audience understand it

#### Datawrapper choropleth & symbol maps: Visualize your data on more than 1000 basemaps.

Here we show examples & explain what they're good for.


Choropleth maps color regions according to values in your dataset. They're great to show clear regional patterns. The map to the right is a choropleth cartogram: The squares are sized according to a country's population.

Datawrapper maps are responsive and interactive: Hover over the squares to see the underlying data as tooltips.

> Go right into the edit step of this choropleth map and play around with the colors and the tooltip

#### Share of individuals using the internet, 2015

Share of the populations who have used the Internet in the last 3 months (via a computer, mobile phone, personal digital assistant, games machine, digital TV etc.): 0% / 25% / 50% / 75% / 100%

### **COMMUNICATING DATA**

#### Tips for good data-driven writing

- Round up and simplify the numbers
  - it has doubled (not 102% increase)
  - 1 in every 3 persons (not 32.5%)
- Use familiar analogies for comparison and easy imagination
  - as tall as 10 KLCC towers
  - as many as KL population
  - can be used to build 20 hospitals
  - as big as 20 football fields






### **COMMUNICATING DATA**

#### Tips for good data-driven writing

- ✓ Slow down the pace of information
- Curate the flow of information, one info at a time. Same for viz.
- Break up number paragraphs with human paragraphs, images or interactive elements to allow rest.
- ✓ Avoid jargons. Translate them.
- √ Test it with your target audience
